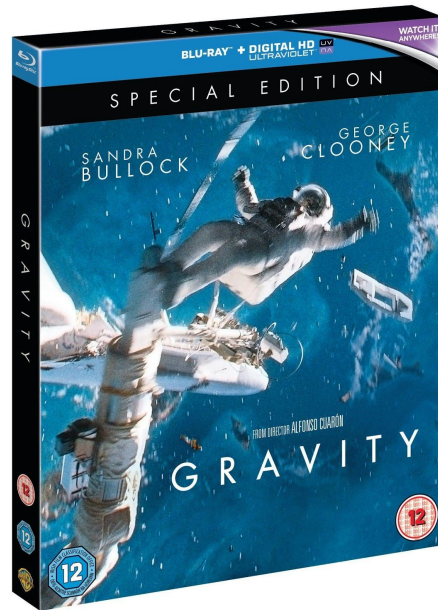

Gravity stars Academy Award® winner Sandra Bullock (*The Blind Side*, 2009), also nominated for her role in **Gravity**, and two-time Oscar® winner George Clooney (*Argo*, 2012; *Syriana*, 2005). The film is stunningly directed by Alfonso Cuarón, whose technical achievement brought him two Oscars® for both best directing and best editing. Cuarón also wrote the screenplay with his son Jonás Cuarón and co-produced the film with David Heyman ("Harry Potter" films). Chris deFaria, Nikki Penny and Stephen Jones served as executive producers.

Synopsis:

Dr. Ryan Stone (Bullock) is a brilliant medical engineer on her first shuttle mission, with veteran astronaut Matt Kowalski (Clooney) in command. But on a seemingly routine mission, disaster strikes.
