We like it because:

Director, Jamie M. Dagg - who won Best First Feature Film for River at the Canadian Screen Awards - does a tremendous job of not only keeping you glued to John's plight and flight, but also making Laos the second character in the film. The country is by turns idyllic and menacing as it helps and hinders John's escape. In this respect, the film is an extraordinary two-hander between Laos and John, played brilliantly by Rossif Sutherland - son of Donald and half-brother of Kiefer. Sutherland is utterly convincing as an American alien trapped in a hostile foreign land; a man drawing closer and closer to the edge as he teeters over a huge moral dilemma.

This moral dilemma adds an extra dimension to River as the audience is not only left fearing for John and willing him on, but also questioning what their own actions would be. We love the way the film keeps you guessing exactly what John will do right up until the very last moment.
