In October, <u>ARROW</u> are proud to present <u>Hellraiser</u>: <u>Quartet of Torment</u> in stunning blood-drenched 4K via ARROW-Player.com. In the 1980s, Clive Barker changed the face of horror fiction, throwing out the rules to expose new vistas of terror and beauty - and with <u>Hellraiser</u>, his first feature film as director, he did the same for cinema. The film was a smash hit and led to three extraordinary sequels - <u>Hellbound</u>: <u>Hellraiser III</u>; <u>Hell on Earth</u>, and <u>Hellraiser</u>: <u>Bloodline</u> - and you can watch them all on <u>ARROW</u> in October. Hell has never looked better!

Also showing in October, suspense horror from South Korea in the truly chilling **The Mimic**. A woman, whose son has been missing for some time, moves to the countryside with her husband, daughter and sick mother-in-law. Out walking one day near Mt. October 11: No Compromise - The Lukas Moodysson Collection



Ever since his debut was heralded as "a young master's first masterpiece" by none other than Ingmar Bergman, director Lukas Moodysson has been hailed internationally as one of Sweden's greatest filmmaking talents, delighting and confounding audiences in equal measure. With his eagerly anticipated new film Together 99 showing at this year's BFI London Film Festival, here's a chance to reacquaint yourself with Moodyson's unique and eclectic oeuvre.

Moodysson's first film, *Fucking Åmål* (released overseas as *Show Me Love*), tells the story of awkward smalltown teenager Agnes and her crush on popular classmate Elin, which unexpectedly blossoms into reallife romance; it was quickly heralded as a new queer cinema touchstone and one of the most authentic portrayals of youthful relationships on film. He swiftly followed this with the bittersweet, satirical 1970s set *Together*, in which the inhabitants of a commune try to reconcile their ideals with their hearts' desires (*Together 99* is the sequel to his acclaimed sophomore film).

Having made a name for himself as the new master of tragicomic, feelgood humanism,

Moodysson suddenly frustrated expectations with a trio of startlingly confrontational works: the hauntingly bleak Lilya 4ever, based on a real life case of a Russian girl sold into sex trafficking in Sweden; the abrasive and semi improvised A Hole in My Heart, detailing the messy (un)making

of an amateur porn video; and the avantgarde Container, narrated in its English version by Jena

Malone (Donnie Darko).

After making his mainstream English language debut with the expansive Mammoth, starring Gael Garcia Bernal and Michelle Williams, Moodysson returned to his roots with We Are The Best! (based on a graphic novel by his wife and 'consigliere' Coco), the charming and funny tale

of three schoolgirls starting a punk band in early 1980s Stockholm.

Moodysson's eclectic filmography can now be appreciated as the work of a singular filmmaking

voice, as avowedly uncompromising and unabashedly political as it is keenly observed, deeply

felt and frequently hilarious.

Jed Shepherd, the co-writer and producer of horror sensations Host and Dashcam, and one of

In the first film, **Hellraiser** (1987) a mysterious puzzle box opens the doors to a dominion where pain and pleasure are indivisible; **Hellbound:** Hellraiser II (1988) expands on Clive Barker's original vision, plunging deeper into the dominion of the Cenobites; **Hellraiser III:** Hell on Earth (1992) sees Pinhead set loose on the sinful streets of New York City to create chaos with a fresh cadre of Cenobitic kin; and **Hellraiser:** Bloodline (1996) begins with the story of the 18th century toymaker who made the Lament Configuration puzzle box.



THE MIMIC



Pinhead is trapped in the Pillar of Souls. Fortunately for him it is bought by a young playboy who owns his own nightclub. Pinhead busies himself escaping by getting the playboy to lure victims to his presence so he can use their blood. Once free, he seeks to destroy the puzzle box so he need never return to Hell, but a female reporter is investigating the grisly murders and stands in his way.

HELLRAISER: BLOODLINE 4K



Hellraiser: Bloodline sinks its hooks into past, present and future with the story of Phillip LeMarchand, the 18th-century toymaker who made the lament configuration puzzle box, his descendent John Merchant - a 20th-century architect whose most recent building bears a striking resemblance to the lament configuration - and Dr. Paul Merchant, a 22nd-century engineer and designer of The Minos, a space station which is a great deal more than it seems.
